GCC's review of on-street parking in Stow is progressing. GCC will produce plans and options for Council feedback by December. There will be public consultation including community drop-in sessions before the plans are finalised.

9. TO NOTE CDC LOCAL PLAN REVIEW CONSULTATION PERIOD STARTS ON 14TH NOVEMBER WITH A DEADLINE OF 2ND JANUARY 2026, AND COUNCIL HAS ENGAGED A PLANNING CONSULTANT TO ASSIST WITH DRAFTING ITS RESPONSE. CDC IS LOOKING FOR FEEDBACK ON WHERE DEVELOPMENT SHOULD GO AND WHAT FACILITIES, SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE WOULD BE NEEDED TO SUPPORT THIS

It was reported that a developer is still interested in developing the site north of Tesco and would be producing new draft proposals. Members noted.

Contribution to TRO for new double yellow lines £ 0 (now part of parking TRO)

Contribution to TRO to amend Oddington Rd speed limit £ 6,000

Softening street scene of the Square £ 4,000

Planning (incl NDP, LP, planning & legal advice) £ 7,000

Dropped kerbs contribution £ 3,000

Total £ 20,000

11. TO FINALISE LOCATIONS FOR NEW 20 MPH SPEED LIMITS TO BE REQUESTED UNDER THE COMMUNITY 20S AND SAFER ROADS INITIATIVE. LOCATIONS ALREADY AGREED ARE ODDINGTON ROAD AND EVESHAM ROAD

Members agreed on three locations as follows:

- a) **RESOLVED** to request the A436/Oddington Road 20 mph zone and 30 mph zone both be extended eastwards as per plan marked up by committee. **Motion carried.**
- b) **RESOLVED** to request the A424/Evesham Road be restricted to 20 mph from the junction with the A429 to a location north of Newlands of Stow as per plan marked up by committee. **Motion carried.**
- c) **RESOLVED** to request the A429/Fosseway be restricted to 20 mph between the Unicorn Junction and the junction with the High Street. **Motion carried.**
