6. TO CONSIDER THE CLERK'S REPORT & MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 14TH APRIL 2026

A new sign at Fountain Court in Digbeth Street has been reported to CDC Planning Enforcement.

Signs pointing to the closed toilets in the Maugersbury Road car park have been reported to GCC Highways, and most of them have been altered. A finger post sign in Sheep Street is in the process of being updated by the Civic Society.

There have been recent instances of vehicles parking on council property including the Shrubbery. The clerk is investigating potential solutions.

Council has received some feedback from residents about GCC's review of on-street parking. This will be passed on to GCC and will be circulated to councillors.

Council has been informed that the Community 20s scheme is not going to cover this area for the foreseeable future, so we have redirected Council's request for reduced speed limits on Oddington Road to the Local Area Highways team.

Cllr Neill had provided an update about the planning application for Bliss in Brewery Yard (change of use to residential), saying it has now been recommended for approval by the officer, and she has called it in to committee. It will go the review panel on 19th May and if accepted would be taken to committee on 20th June. Someone from Stow Town Council would be invited to speak.
