**1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

**2. DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA**

Members were reminded to declare any interests in items on the agenda as the meeting progressed.

**3. MINUTES**

**a) To sign as a correct record the minutes of meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2019**

**RESOLVED** - Proposed Cllr White, seconded Cllr Davies that the minutes should be signed by the chairman as a true and accurate record of the meeting. **RECORD OF VOTING** - 4 in favour, 2 abstentions. **Motion carried.**

**b) To sign as a correct record the minutes of meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

**RESOLVED** - Proposed Cllr Clarke, seconded Cllr Scarsbrook that the minutes should be signed by the chairman as a true and accurate record of the meeting. **RECORD OF VOTING** - 3 in favour, 3 abstentions. **Motion carried.**

**c) To sign as a correct record the minutes of meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

**RESOLVED** - Proposed Cllr Davies, seconded Cllr White that the minutes should be signed by the chairman as a true and accurate record of the meeting. **RECORD OF VOTING** - 4 in favour, 2 abstentions. **Motion carried.**

**4. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Met with GCC Highways mainly to discuss Back Walls but also traffic volumes in Digbeth Street, Well Lane and Sheep Street. The recent survey had weakened the case for Back Walls based on speed but Highways did have concerns about volumes. Highways engineers were also concerned about putting additional traffic onto Sheep Street. The Adlestrop Bridge weight limit was expected to reduce volumes and Highways would reassess the Back Walls situation after the weight limit was in place. Highways would look at Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) signs for Sheep Street and the possibility of a footpath on one side of Back Walls. Regarding Digbeth Street, the Church Street solution was no longer an option but this council should keep pressing for a solution. Council had agreed to contribute £5000 to the Adlestrop Bridge weight limit. Clerk had completed the match funding form which meant GCC would contribute a similar amount and County Cllr Nigel Moor was also contributing from his fund. Exact timing was not known yet but the experimental weight limit was going ahead and making progress.
