A436 Oddington Road, Stow-on-the-Wold

Dear Sir/Madam

What: Road closure for carriageway resurfacing
Where: A436 Oddington Road - see overleaf for details of the exact location
When: 5th to 14th September (excl. weekends and bank holiday), from 09:30-15:30
to allow the morning and evening traffic flow unhindered.

We will shortly be resurfacing the road at the above location. In order to ensure the safety of both road users and our work force we have under Sections 14, 15 & 16 of the Road Traffic Act 1984, as amended, made a Temporary Traffic Order to **close the road**.

Please note: Due to the type of engineering activities required to be undertaken with carriageway resurfacing, the Road Closure extents can cover an area greater than the actual area being resurfaced. This is to allow for such activities as movement and placement of machinery and material. This ensures that both road users and our work force remain safe whilst the works are being undertaken.

ACCESS

In accordance with the Temporary Traffic Order, we are not permitted to allow any person or vehicle to proceed along the closed roads; with the exception of pedestrian access to properties, emergency vehicles, and statutory undertakers responding to an emergency situation.

Therefore, if you normally drive into or out of this area during the hours when the road closure is in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements.

In exceptional circumstances, some level of access may be considered on a case by case basis and only where it does not impact on our ability to undertake the necessary engineering works and where it is safe to do so.

We have to advise that any granted access through a road closure will be at the drivers risk as it is a works site and the carriageway may have raised iron work and a temporary surface.

DIVERSIONS

We have established official diversion routes that will be signposted and is suitable for all vehicles that normally use the route. With regards to local traffic movements, there remain alternative routes which are outside of the road closure area that can be accessed at the discretion of the individual road user.

SCHEME SPECIFIC DETAILS:

We are conscious that the access to and from St Edwards Drive is going to be affected by this essential work and do request that journeys in and out are limited to those that are essential only during the working window. Works will be phased to allow essential access from one side or the other. It is not possible to accurately predict the timing of the switchover due to nature of the work, information will be provided at on site by the operatives at the access points.


