Stow on the Wold Police Station Reception Opening Times

Good afternoon

Further to the recent Community Alert sent out by PCSO Charlie Symes setting out the contact details and opening times for the Reception Office at Stow on the Wold Police Station, owing to retirement, it is likely that this Reception will be closed to the public from the start of October 2019.

At this point, I must reiterate that, to the best of my knowledge, there are no current plans to close Stow on the Wold Police Station; both your local Neighbourhood Officers, and the 24/7 Response Officers will continue to operate out of Stow on the Wold Police Station.

Owing to re-organisation within Gloucestershire Constabulary, the decision as to whether to close Stow on the Wold Police Station Reception to the public falls under the remit of the Force Control Room at HQ in Gloucester. Unfortunately the Neighbourhood Policing Team based in the Cotswolds has no control over, or say in the decision.

This being the case, any questions you may have about whether or not, timescales, etc. reference the Reception at Stow on the Wold Police Station should be directed to the manager responsible, Jayne Jones, at the Force Control Room at HQ in Gloucester, and not to the Neighbourhood Policing Team. 
