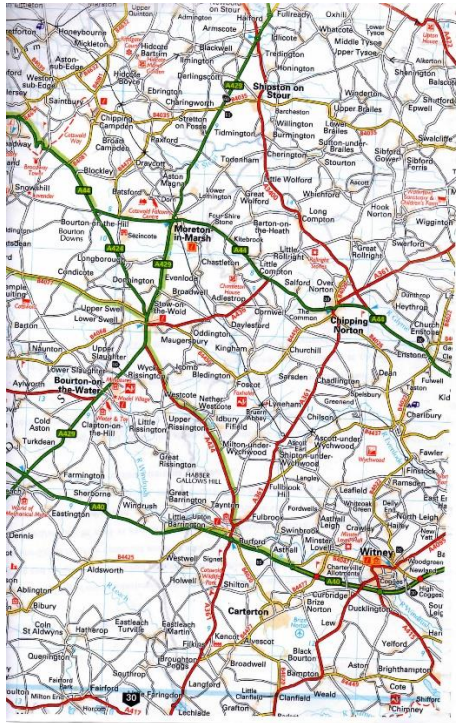


UPDATE: THE INTRODUCTION OF AN EXPERIMENTAL 7.5-TONNE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT RESTRICTION ON THE A361 AT BURFORD OXFORDSHIRE AND ON THE BRIDGE OVER THE RIVER EVENLODE AND THE RAILWAY NEAR ADLESTROP ON THE A436 GLOUCESTERSHIRE. (THE ALTERNATIVE ROUTE FOR THE HGV'S BEING THE A40/A429 INTO GLOUCESTERSHIRE).

I have been advised that Oxfordshire County Council intend to advertise their order on the 23rd July and it will come into force on the 5th August 2020. Gloucestershire County Council are working to a similar timetable. Gloucestershire County Council have agreed to monitor the HGV traffic flows resulting from these changes at Sheep Street, Stow-on-the-Wold and Stow Road Bledington.
