**6. TO CONSIDER THE CLERK'S REPORT & MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 6<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2024**

GCC Highways have advised that protruding manhole cover opposite the Prince of India has been repaired.

Depressions that have formed in the road behind the cross in the Square have been reported to GCC Highways.

Planning training has been arranged on 11th March for those members who wish to attend. We await advice from CDC about their proposed planning roadshows.

GCC Highways has been contacted about 2-hour time limit signage removed from the Square and not replaced.

GCC Highways has been asked about the possibility of installing signage in the Square directing drivers to the Maugersbury Road car park.

Missing Road Closed signs at the end of Church Walk have been reported to GCC Highways.

- Fosseway car park
- Stow Social Club
- Land behind Majestic Wines, Station Road
- Doctors Surgery, Maugersbury Road

**13. TO CONSIDER WHETHER COUNCIL WISHES TO REQUEST THAT THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINE IN DIGBETH STREET OUTSIDE THE CROCK SHOP BE REPLACED WITH A SINGLE YELLOW LINE WHERE THE ROAD IS WIDER, AND PARKING RESTRICTED TO 20 MINUTES BETWEEN 09:00 AND 17:00 DAILY**

**RESOLVED** to request that this be considered by GCC as part of the parking review. **Motion carried.**

**14. TO CONSIDER WHETHER COUNCIL WISHES TO REQUEST THAT LINES BE REMOVED FROM THE SECTION OF DIGBETH STREET OUTSIDE OSCAR & ME. IT WAS PREVIOUSLY AGREED TO REQUEST DOUBLE YELLOW LINES ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE, WHICH WOULD PROVIDE SPACE FOR PARKING ON THE OSCAR & ME (WESTERN) SIDE OF THE STREET. RESOLVED** to request that this be considered by GCC as part of the parking review. **Motion carried.**

**15. TO CONSIDER WHETHER COUNCIL WISHES TO REQUEST THAT IN THE WIDEST PART OF CHURCH STREET, IN THE COTSWOLD BAGUETTES VICINITY, THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINE BE REPLACED WITH A SINGLE YELLOW LINE, AND PARKING RESTRICTED TO 20 MINUTES BETWEEN 09:00 AND 17:00 DAILY**  
**RESOLVED** to request that this be considered by GCC as part of the parking review. **Motion carried.**
