Council reported to GCC that the street light in George Alley was not working. Council also requested that this light be replaced with a traditional lamp as originally intended. The light is now working.

Council has received more complaints about parking at the junction of Well Lane and Queen Henrietta Place causing serious problems for residents. Council has again contacted GCC to request repainting of the lines and parking enforcement.

Council has requested repainting of the faded line markings in the area outside the Queen's Head.

Potholes on the A424 between Stow and the Rissingtons have been reported to GCC Highways.

Council has contacted the agents about broken paving in Talbot Court. A response has been received that they are working on a solution and have put up warning signs in the meantime.

Committee members need to be familiar with the adopted Neighbourhood Plan, Design Code and the Cotswold Design Code. Copies will be provided at the next meeting.
