Stow Town Council, takes responsibility for funding, maintaining and putting up the Christmas tree and lights in the town. It also organises the Christmas Tree Lights Switch On event which this year is on **Friday 5th December 2025 at 5.00 pm.**

In recent years, the Council has invested in new lights and maintaining the current ones, including those in the trees on Stocks Green. The Council intends to continue spreading Christmas cheer with an attractive display that is not only enjoyable for the residents but also encourages visitors to the town to use the shops, restaurants, bars and cafés.

The annual cost of providing and installing the lights in the town is substantial and is funded via the precept. This 'precept' is money Council receives from residents, via their council tax. The Council does not receive any funds from business rates.
