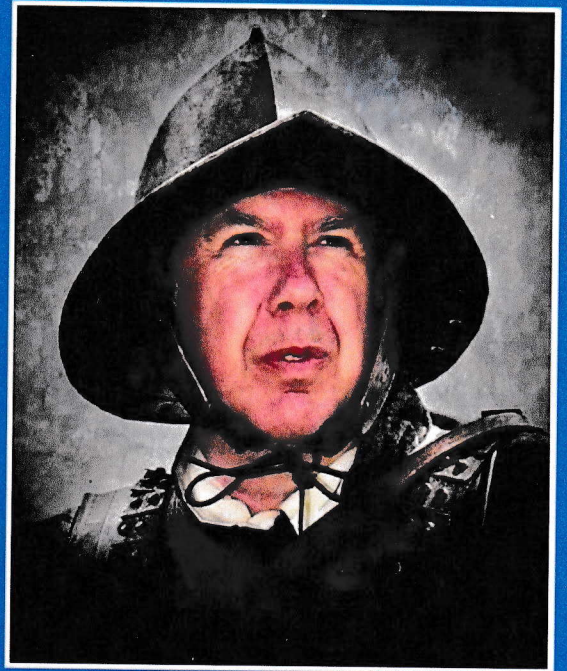


THE SEALED KNOT IS VISITING STOW!

The 380th Anniversary of The Battle of Stow

Stow & District Civic Society in association with *The Battlefields Trust* and *The Sealed Knot* will be marking this event with a gathering on Stocks Green followed by a short memorial service at the commemorative headstone in the Churchyard and in the Church at the tomb of Captain Hastings Keyte. Later in the afternoon a guided walk to the site of the Battle will outline the events of the early hours of 21st March 1646 when this battle between Royalists and Parliamentarians ended the 1st English Civil War and would lead ultimately to the beheading of King Charles I.
