Incidents of Interest

Unfortunately burglaries continue to be fairly prevalent across the county with offenders generally targeting large rural dwellings (mainly to steal jewellery, gold or silver items). They also target properties with high performance cars in order to facilitate further offences and evade police. The offenders tend to be fairly organised, travelling into the county using cars on “false” plates. Police are grateful for any reports of suspicious persons or vehicles as they help us to link gangs to the area.

Police are very aware of the recent issues caused by local youths riding dangerously on mopeds. One moped was recently seized whilst another was recovered after being set alight in a field (on the evening of 18th March).

The youths are also believed to be responsible for several thefts from the Coop and Budgens although this particular problem appears to be massively underreported. Efforts are being made to address their behaviour.
